In order to receive funding for the first semester, the recipients must provide the name and address of the university to which the payment must be directed, along with the proper student I.D. number as supplied by the university. For subsequent semesters to be paid, a copy of the bill along with the grades for the prior semester must be provided, or no funds will be disbursed.
4. To be considered for renewal, the committee will provide a renewal application which must be completed and returned to the committee. A GPA of 2.5 for the prior year must be maintained in order to be considered for renewal.
5. If a student changes schools during the period covered by the scholarship, prior notification to the scholarship committee will need to be obtained in order to maintain the scholarship.
