Students put cards in the mailbox outside the main office. Twice a month three (3) students' names will be drawn from the front office. Those students and two (2) of their friends will have lunch at the *Hard Work Café* where they will enjoy pizza, pop and a movie! The winner will also receive a free T-Shirt!

LOCK-IN

= Students making 1st midterm honor roll AND 1st quarter honor roll or having perfect attendance from the beginning of the school year will be invited to the fall lock-in. Students making 3rd midterm honor roll AND 3rd quarter honor roll or 3rd quarter perfect attendance will be invited to the spring lock-in. Lock-ins are from 4-7pm with games, activities, food and lots of fun!

First in Line Pass

= Students may receive a pass from a teacher and they will be allowed to be first in line at lunch! The students present the passes to a lunch supervisor.

Student of the Month

= Teachers nominate students and students receive awards: Certificate and a 1-week "first in line pass" for lunch!
