

# REGULAR TEACHER CONTRACT

Prescribed pursuant to Ind. Code 20-28-6-3 as the regular and uniform contract  
for the employment of teachers pursuant to Ind. Code 20-28-6-4(b)

This regular teacher contract ("Contract") is by and between the governing body of the **NEW CASTLE COMM SCHOOL CORP** ("Corporation") and **ADAM J MCDANIEL** ("Teacher"). **ADAM J MCDANIEL** is a teacher as defined in Ind. Code 20-18-2-22.

In exchange for the Teacher's services described below, the Corporation and the Teacher agree that:


1. The Teacher shall teach in the schools of the Corporation for the school term beginning **July 01, 2023** and ending on **June 30, 2024**. Ind. Code 20-28-6-2(a) (3) (A)
2. The school term described in paragraph 1 immediately above for services under this Contract consists of **260.00** days. Ind. Code 20-28-6-2(a) (3) (B)
3. The number of hours per day the Teacher is expected to work under this Contract is **8.00**. Ind. Code 20-28-6-2(a) (3) (E)
4. The Corporation shall pay the Teacher for services under this Contract the total salary of **\$131,327.00** during the school year. Ind. Code 20-28-6-2(a) (3) (C)
5. The Corporation shall pay this amount in **26** installments on a **Biweekly basis**. Ind. Code 20-28-6-2(a) (3) (D) Ind. Code 20-28-6-5(1)
6. This Contract may be cancelled during its term for any of the grounds set forth in Ind. Code 20-28-7.5-1(b) pursuant to the procedures set forth in Ind. Code 20-28-7.5-2 and Ind. Code 20-28-7.5-3.
7. This Contract is a public record pursuant to Ind. Code 20-28-6-2(d) and Ind. Code 5-14-3.



## **ADDENDUM TO TEACHER CONTRACT OF**

**Adam McDaniel**

### **ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT** **NEW CASTLE COMMUNITY SCHOOL CORPORATION**

IT IS HEREBY AGREED by and between the New Castle Community School Corporation, ("Corporation"), acting by and through its Board of School Trustees ("Board") and Adam McDaniel, ("Assistant to the Superintendent"), that this Addendum to the Teacher Contract of Adam McDaniel as Assistant to the Superintendent of the New Castle Community School Corporation shall be a part of the original Teacher Contract of Adam McDaniel as Assistant to the Superintendent for the New Castle Community School Corporation commencing on July 1, 2021, and continuing in effect until June 30, 2024.

#### **WITNESSETH**

1. This Addendum, including the attached Exhibit "A" is executed contemporaneous with the original Teacher Contract of Adam McDaniel as Assistant to the Superintendent for the New Castle Community School Corporation ("Teacher Contract") and is incorporated into the Teacher Contract as if set forth therein in full.

2. The salary set forth in the Teacher Contract shall not be increased, decreased, or otherwise affected by any change in the salary schedule for Teachers in the New Castle Community School Corporation.

3. Assistant to the Superintendent shall be eligible to participate in any Corporation sponsored health insurance plan(s) on the same terms and conditions as other eligible employees of Corporation. Assistant to the Superintendent shall receive an annual contribution by Corporation of \$3,550 into his Health Savings Account.

4. Corporation shall provide Assistant to the Superintendent with, and pay all cost, except one dollar (\$ 1.00) annually, a long-term disability insurance policy providing for a 66-2/3% benefit and shall guarantee ninety (90) days illness leave from the day of disability for the implementation of the benefits under such policy..

5. Corporation shall provide Assistant to the Superintendent with, and pay all cost except one dollar (\$1.00) annually, a policy of group term life insurance insuring the life of Assistant to the Superintendent with a death benefit in the amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00).

6. Assistant to the Superintendent, subject to the approval of the Board, may attend appropriate professional development meetings and activities at the local, state and national level. The necessary expenses of his attendance shall be paid by Corporation in accordance with Corporation's normal procedures and practice.

7. Assistant to the Superintendent shall be entitled to receive a vacation with pay of twenty (20) working days per year. Unused vacation days may accumulate to a total not to exceed fifty (50). If, at the time of retirement, Assistant to the Superintendent has unused vacation days, he shall be compensated for said days up to a maximum of thirty (30) at his current daily rate of pay. In the
